Life never stays still; we have had a week full of progress at Northcroft School and we want to thank the team across Amegreen, the young people and the parents for their patience and kindness during our first week at Northcroft School.

The Haywards Farm School and Northcroft School staffing team took a great breath of relief as we opened both schools on Monday morning, and all children and young people arrived at their schools ready to learn.

We have some staff members who will be supporting both schools initially, to ensure that the solid relationships that have been built between staff and young people will be maintained and that consistency with an all-thorough vision from Haywards Farm School to Northcroft is upheld.

Michelle, Haywards Farm School's Reading Lead, will be based at Northcroft on a Wednesday. Michelle will continue supporting the children who are on a phonics scheme and those in the preliminary stages of moving from this scheme and onto Accelerated Reader. Michelle will join the young people for lunch and work her way through the cohort supporting reading, handwriting, and spelling.

Gill, our school cook for Haywards Farm School, will join Northcroft School on Thursdays, where she will be cooking with our young people in the afternoon.

Leigh-Ann, Haywards Farm School's Therapeutic Practitioner trained in ELSA and Thrive, will join Northcroft School on Wednesday afternoons to support emotional literacy interventions. On Monday afternoon, Leigh-Ann will also transition the year 7 young people to the Paddocks.

Sam, our amazing school Office Manager for Haywards Farm School, will join Northcroft on a Tuesday to work alongside staff and parents to ensure the school is fully compliant.
